SUBJECT: Army in Europe Command Policy Letter 1, Army in Europe Command Policy Letters

1. This letter supersedes Army in Europe Command Policy Letter 1, 16 February 2004.
2. Army in Europe command policy letters are statements of CG, USAREUR/7A, policy that are applicable to USAREUR major subordinate and tenant commands (AE Reg 10-5, app A), to the United States Army Installation Management Agency, Europe Region Office, and to their Soldiers, civilian employees, and family members. These letters are used to provide one or more of the following:
 - a. Policy that has not yet been published in an Army in Europe publication. Once the policy has been incorporated into a regional publication, the letter may be rescinded.
 - b. The highest level of command emphasis in areas that may or may not be covered in Army or Army in Europe publications.
 - c. Statements of policy concerning special-interest areas, such as equal opportunity, when required by HQDA.
