SUBJECT: Commercial Long-Distance Services for Official Calls



2. When calling the continental United States from the European region, DSN operators may use commercial long-distance services for official calls that are not being made for command-and-control purposes. Operators will use the most cost-effective service available when placing these calls.

3. DSN operators will not transfer nonemergency morale calls to other operators for "off-netting" (transferring the call to a commercial line) if those calls result in fees being charged to the U.S. Government.
