
SUBJECT: USAREUR Digital Training Strategy

This memorandum expires in 1 year.

1. Reference USAREUR Regulation 350-1, Training in USAREUR, 22 July 2002.
2. The enclosed USAREUR Digital Training Strategy (UDTS) expands on digital training described in USAREUR Regulation 350-1. Specifically, the UDTS—
  - a. Incorporates digital skills training into all echelons of Battle Command Training and battle-focused training.
  - b. Takes into account that—
    - (1) Units have different levels of digital command, control, communications, computers, intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance (C4ISR) systems.
    - (2) New systems will be distributed in the future and units will continue to have varied levels of digital capability.
  - c. Gives commanders a framework to use when planning training with current digital systems and enough flexibility to be able to adapt training as other capabilities become available.
