SUBJECT: Command Supply Discipline Program

This memorandum expires in 1 year.

1. This memorandum supersedes memorandum, HQ USAREUR/7A, AEAGD-SD, 11 March 2004, subject as above.

2. References:

a. AR 710-2, Supply Policy Below the National Level, 25 February 2004.

b. AE Regulation 71-32, Excess Equipment Retention, 22 July 2003.

3. As USAREUR units redeploy to the European theater and reconstitute equipment and supplies, commanders must reestablish normal supply discipline and give immediate attention to property accountability. Units must use the Command Supply Discipline Program (CSDP) (AR 710-2) and their limited time and resources on this reconstitution task.

4. The CSDP is a compilation of regulatory requirements that standardizes supply discipline and helps eliminate fraud, waste, and abuse. Tables B-1 through B-7 of AR 710-2 provide procedures, checklists, and the frequency for making CSDP checks.

5. Units will report property in excess of their approved Logistics Army Authorization Document System (LOGTAADS) and modification table of organization and equipment (MTOE) authorizations according to procedures in AE Regulation 71-32. Units must also correct deficiencies when they are discovered; fraud, waste, and abuse will not be tolerated. All USAREUR major subordinate commands must contact the POC listed below with an inspection schedule that will be completed before this memorandum expires.
